She died Dec. 15 in Fairfield, Iowa, at age 91.

State College to help in establishing its reading education program in the late 1940s. After retiring in 1965, she devoted more time to the reading association and worked as a consultant in Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Japan and the United States.
