

# Paul McKee (author)

Dr. **Paul McKee** (October 14, 1898 – November 26, 1974) was a university professor, an author of children's books, and was regarded as "one of the most eminent scholars in his field". McKee earned a doctorate at the University of Iowa before joining the faculty at the University of Northern Colorado.<sup>[1][2]</sup>

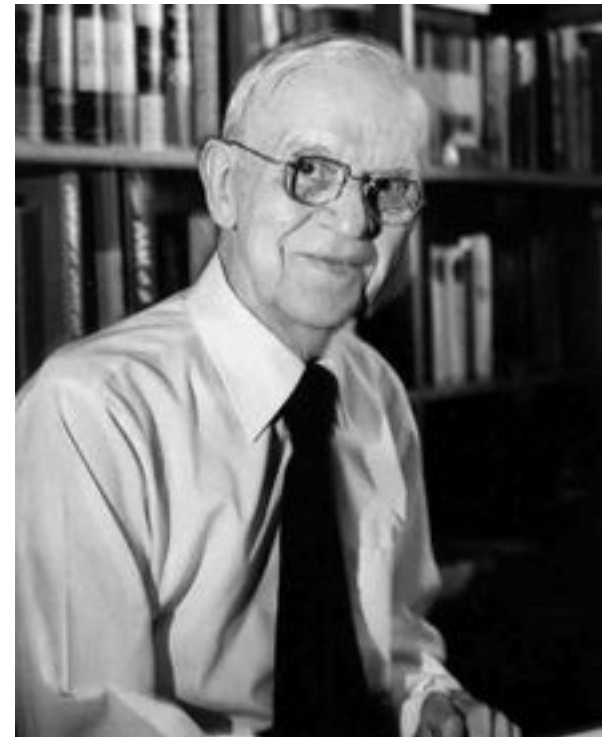
